# **Hebrews 11:1-3 on Creation**

#### Verse 1

- Definition of faith Faith is the title deed of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen.
- Important note: It takes faith to believe any theory of how things came into being: Creationism or Evolution

#### Verse 2

- Verse 2 is introducing all the elders mentioned in Chap 11 who lived lives of faith. Verse 2 is introducing all the college courses on faith. Verse 3 will introduce the first course.
- Faith 101 = believing that God is Creator

#### Verse 3

- Source of creation = God (Theos = God)
- Content of creation = everything (aion = worlds, universe, ages).

- Method of creation = God spoke (*rhema*) and created out of nothing (*ex nihilo*); method = God's Word (John 1:1-5; Col. 1:16-17; Genesis 1)
- Reflection Question: As one created in the image of God, what am I "creating" with my words? Am I building up or tearing down with my words? (Eph. 4:29; Proverbs 12:18; 15:4; 16:24; 18:4,21)
