WALK OF HOLINESS

Festivals Appointed By God For His People

<i>Festival</i>	<i>Purpose</i>
Sabbath (23:1-3)	A Holy day of rest celebrating God's rest at creation
Passover and Unleavened bread (23:4-8)	Celebrating Gods deliverance from slavery in Egypt
First Fruits (23:9-14)	Dedicating to God the first portion of the earliest crop (barley)
Weeks Pentecost) (23:15-22)	Praising God for the harvest and dedication of the first portion of the later crops
	50 days after first fruits
Trumpets (23:23-25)	Celebrating the beginning of the civil new year
Day of Atonement (23:26-32)	Atonement for the sins of the entire nation
Booths (tabernacles) (23:33-44)	Celebrating the deliverance from Egypt and the provision of the Lord while in the wilderness
Year of Jubilee (25:8-55)	No reaping or sowing and all land is returned to original owner and slaves to their families

Why Celebrate these feasts

- They reminded the people of Gods deliverance
- They reminded the people they were leaving the old life behind and entering a new way of living
- They reminded the people that God was their provider
- They reminded the people to show joy over and be thankful for the harvest
- They restored fellowship with God
- They renewed Israels commitment to God and to trust in His guidance and protection
