Main Idea: Moses put his *faith* in a greater **Fortune** than Egypt

1 – By Faith... Moses' Parents Modeled Faith (v. 23)

- Amran (dad) and Jochebed (mom)
- Acts 7:20 He was beautiful in God's sight.
- Timeline of parenting Moses:
 - o Surrendered him at the beginning of his life
 - Took advantage of the finite amount of time to train him
 - o Surrendered him again as a teenager
- Francis Chan "Children are more perceptive than many parents think. They can tell if our words are only words. We can say all day long that we love Jesus more than them, but they see where our time and resources go. They aren't blind to our affections nor to our lack of prayer and worship. Kids know when we fake it. After all, don't you know the truth about your parents? When you became a young adult, weren't you able to look back at the relationship of your parents and know the truth? You knew whether their love for each other was actually deep or just a show. You know now whether their faith was a religious duty or a source of life. You know whether they loved you more than they loved Jesus."

2 – B	y Faith Moses Chose to be Mistreated (v. 24-26) Now this is HIS own faith.
•	Charles Spurgeon - "What was the source of Moses' decision? Scripture says it was faith, otherwise some would insist that it we the force of blood. We know right well that the sons of godly parents are not led to adore the true God by reason of their birth. Grace does not run in the blood; sin may, but righteousness does not. It was faith, not blood, that impelled Moses in the way of truth."
•	Acts 7:22 – And Moses was instructed in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and he was mighty in his words and deeds. Luke 15:17 – But when he came to himself

•	HE CONSIDERED: A Greater Fortune (v. 26) Hebrews 10:34-36 — You joyfully accepted the plundering of yo property, since you knew that you yourselves had a <u>better</u> <u>possession</u> and an abiding one. Therefore, do not throw away your confidence, which has a <u>great reward</u> . For you have need endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised.

3 - By Faith... Moses Obeyed (v. 27)

- Moses actually left Egypt twice:
 - o First To escape Pharoah (*Fear*)
 - Second To lead the people out of Egypt (Faith)
- What separated these two? The Burning Bush (Exodus 3-4)
- The land of Midian wasn't sin, but it was safe. It was holding Moses back from his calling.
- Hebrews 12:1-2 Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.
